

New First Grade Enrollment Requirements

If your new first grade student (6 years old by December 2nd of the enrolling year) has never been enrolled in a public or private school, we will need the following items.

If you are enrolling your student in first grade and they have been enrolled in a public or private school, kindergarten, a *Transfer of Records* form will be required. All other required forms should be in the cumulative file. Christian Life Academy will request the cumulative file from their previous school.

1. **School Entry Health Check-up** (Required of California residents): Print out this form, make an appointment with your doctor for a first grade health check-up, take this form with you for the doctor to complete and send the form with all other enrollment forms to Christian Life Academy.

If you do not want your child to have the health check-up, you may print out the *School Entry Health Check-up Waiver*, sign and send the waiver with enrollment forms. This check-up is not to be waived for inconvenience sake.

2. **Copy of Immunization Record:** This is the yellow immunization card (CA) or an “official” record issued in another state by your doctor. To enter or transfer into public or private elementary and secondary schools, children under 18 years of age must have required immunizations.

Reference: Health and Safety Code Sections 120325-120380; CA Administrative code, Title 17, Sections 6000-6075.

Exemptions: The law allows parents/guardians to choose exemptions from immunization requirements based on their personal beliefs, and for medical exemption. The law does now allow exemptions simply because of inconvenience. Contact the school if you do not immunize or have chosen not to get certain immunizations.
